

SAFE HARBOR PRIVACY POLICY

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. is strongly committed to protecting the privacy of those who entrust us with their personal information. We strive to comply with all applicable privacy legislation in the jurisdictions where we carry on our business.

In furtherance of our commitment, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. endorses the Safe Harbor Agreement between the United States and the European Union, with respect to personal data processed as part of our human resources and contract research activities. Accordingly, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. adheres to the Safe Harbor Privacy Principles.

Scope

This Privacy Policy sets forth how Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc handles personal data transferred from countries in the European Economic Area to the United States that are collected or received in managing our workforce and in conducting human resources and contract research activities.

Definitions

The following terms are used throughout this document and are defined here for clarification.

Personal Data

"Personal data" means any information or set of information that identifies or can reasonably be used to identify an individual. Personal data do not include information that is encoded or anonymized, or publicly available information that has not been combined with non-public personal information.

Sensitive Personal Data

"Sensitive personal data" means personal information that reveals race, ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, or that concerns health or sex life. Information will be treated as sensitive personal data where it is received from a third party that treats and identifies it as sensitive.

Privacy Principles

The following privacy principles apply to the collection, use and disclosure of personal data by Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. in conducting human resources and contract research activities.

Website

Our website does not collect information that personally identifies individuals except when that information is provided to Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. voluntarily. Our website does not issue cookies to visitors for information gathering purposes.

Identifying Purposes

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. will inform individuals about the purposes for which we collect and use personal data about them, how to contact us, the types of third parties with whom we may share personal data, and how individuals may limit the use and sharing of such data. This information will be provided when individuals are first asked to provide personal data or as soon as practicable thereafter.

For sensitive personal data, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. will give an individual an explicit (opt in) choice if the information is to be disclosed to a third party or used for a purpose other than those for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized by the individual.

Access

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. will provide individuals with reasonable access to personal data about them and they may request the correction or amendment of personal data that they demonstrate to be incorrect or incomplete.

Transfers to agents, partners or contractors

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc will only share personal data to such parties in connection with services that these parties perform for, or with Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. Such third parties will be restricted from using this data in any way other than providing services for or on behalf of Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. Where we have knowledge that these parties are using or sharing personal data in a way that is contrary to these principles, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc will take reasonable steps to prevent or stop such processing.

Transfer

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc will only transfer personal data to a non-agent, partner or contractor where consistent with the notice provided to the individuals who are the subject of the data and any consent that those individuals have provided or where otherwise required under “Limitation on Scope of Principles” below.

Information Integrity

Subject to the “Limitation on Scope Principles”, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc will only use and share personal data about individuals in a way that is consistent with the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently authorized by those individuals. To the extent necessary for those purposes, Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc will take reasonable steps to ensure that the data are accurate, complete, and current.

Data Security

Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. will adopt physical, technical and administrative safeguards appropriate to the quality of the data and will take reasonable precautions to protect personal data from loss, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. We encourage individuals covered by this Policy to raise any concerns that they have about the way that we process their personal data by contacting us at the address below, and we will do our best to resolve them.

Limitation on Scope of Principles

Adherence by Huntingdon Life Sciences, Inc. to these privacy principles may be limited to the extent required for the purposes of prevention of crime or to meet legal, governmental, national security or public interest obligations.
